**On his arrival at Trinity Church in Karachi on the eve of Christmas, Chief Justice Mr. Justice Gulzar Ahmed said, “You have as much legal protection as anyone else.”**

They have done tremendous service to Pakistan. I am really grateful to them, I salute them and I honor them. They are great people of Pakistan. Still Christian community is fully motivated and working towards the greatness of Pakistan making the country great, further great and there is full contribution of the community.

I feel sometimes that in some matters the community is not dealt with in a similar way as it should be dealt with but the constitution gives you similar protection as other citizens of Pakistan, You are as a citizen of Pakistan as any other citizen of Pakistan.

As Chief Justice of Supreme Court of Pakistan It has always taken it as a big step to see that none of the religious minorities is deprived of their rights, whatever they are entitled to get it and they get it, we provide them by giving them Judgments We will continue to do that always.

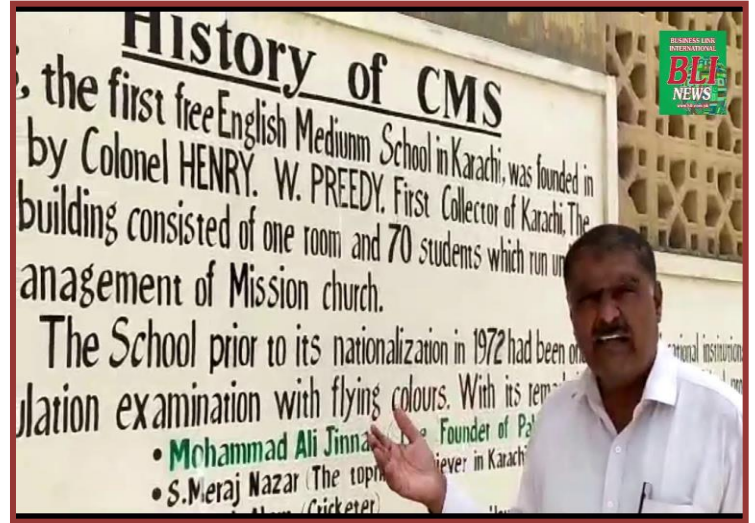
