Recommendations

- 3) All the human beings are equal by birth or without any races discrimination, so Pakistani laws like other International countries guarantees of protection to all minorities residing in Pakistan without any fear and suppression.
- 4) Liberty of free press is our first advantage without any moral and ethical binding.
- 5) It is pertinent that Landmark judgment on dated 19 June, 2014 (PLD 699, 2014) regarding the fundamental rights of Minorities should be implemented without further delay.**
- 6) The declaration executed by European delegation to Pakistan in collaboration with interfaith Council for peace and harmony on dated 9 th December, 2020 in Islamabad should be practized and implemented in Islamic Republic of Pakistan on the earliest basis and in true spirit.**
