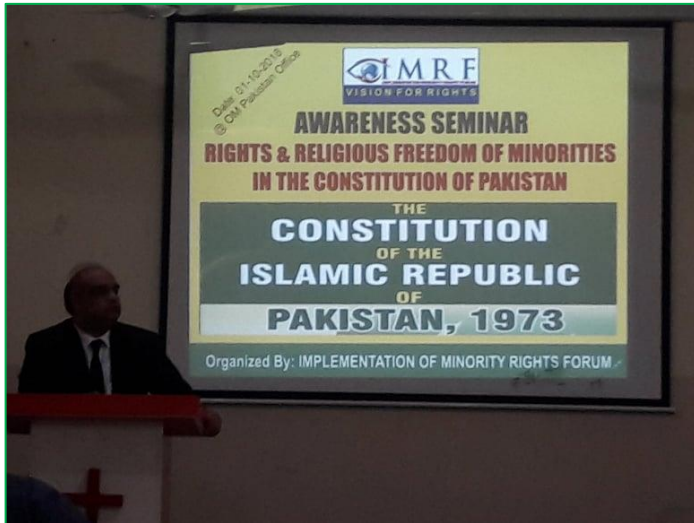

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## CJP orders probe into Gujjar Khan Incident



LAHORE: A two-judge bench at the Supreme Court Lahore Chief Justice Mian Saqib Nisar Sunday ordered a probe into the Gujjar Khan incident, in which the members of land mafia attacked a Christian family and torched their house and a car. On Sept 21, at least 12 suspects tortured the family of Bashir Masih, a retired sanitary worker of the Punjab Health Department, and set fire to their possessions in a bid to grab the property. The apex court took notice after Implementation Minority Rights Forum (IMRF) Chairman Samuel Payara appeared before the Supreme Court Lahore registry and filed an application regarding the incident. Taking notice, the chief justice sought a detailed report from the Punjab government and Inspector General Punjab Police Arif Nawaz Khan. The court also ordered Additional Inspector General of Police (Legal), Abdul Rab, to investigate the incident thoroughly. The chief justice said that the provincial government will compensate the affected family after police submit its report on the incident

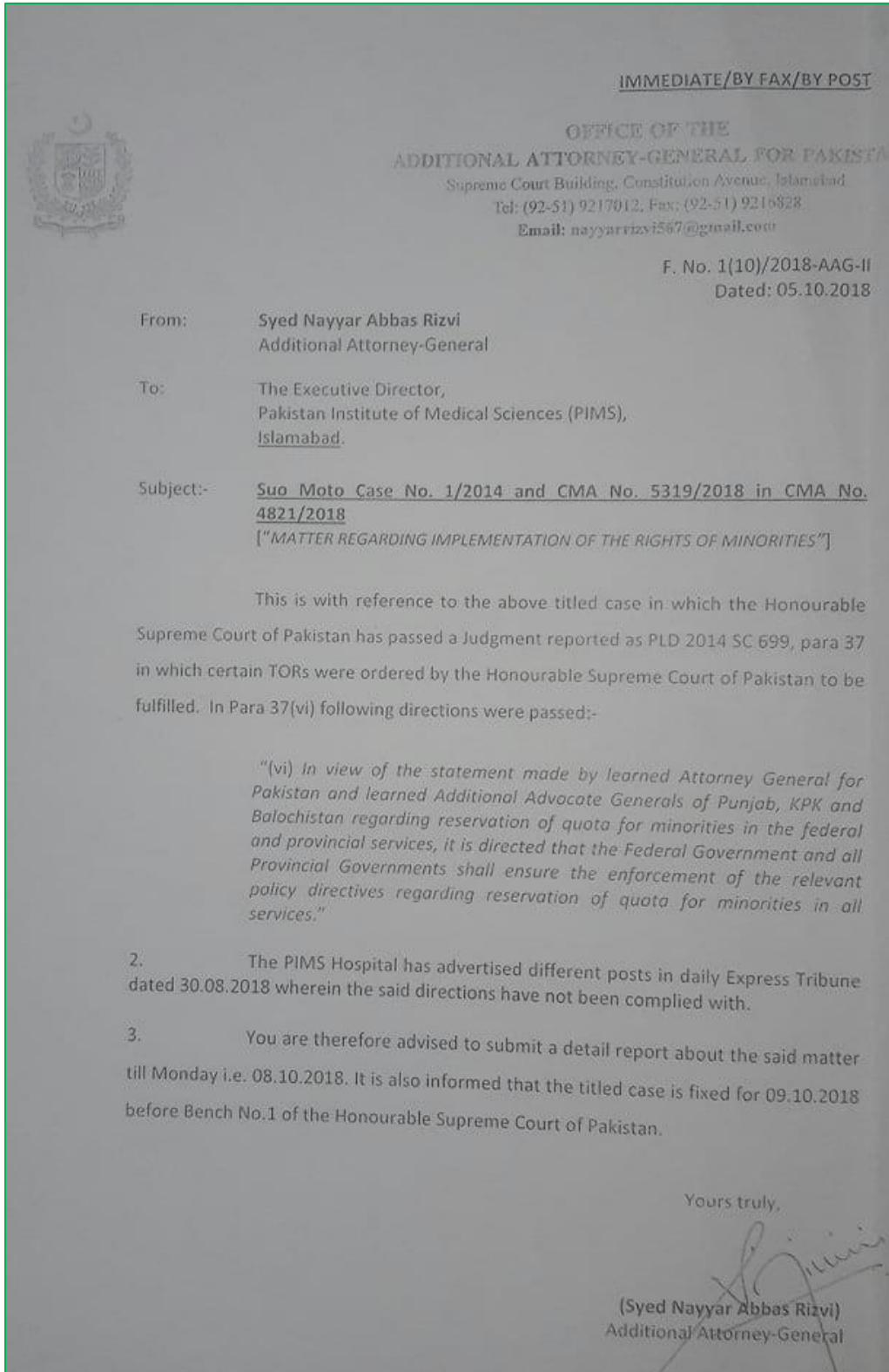

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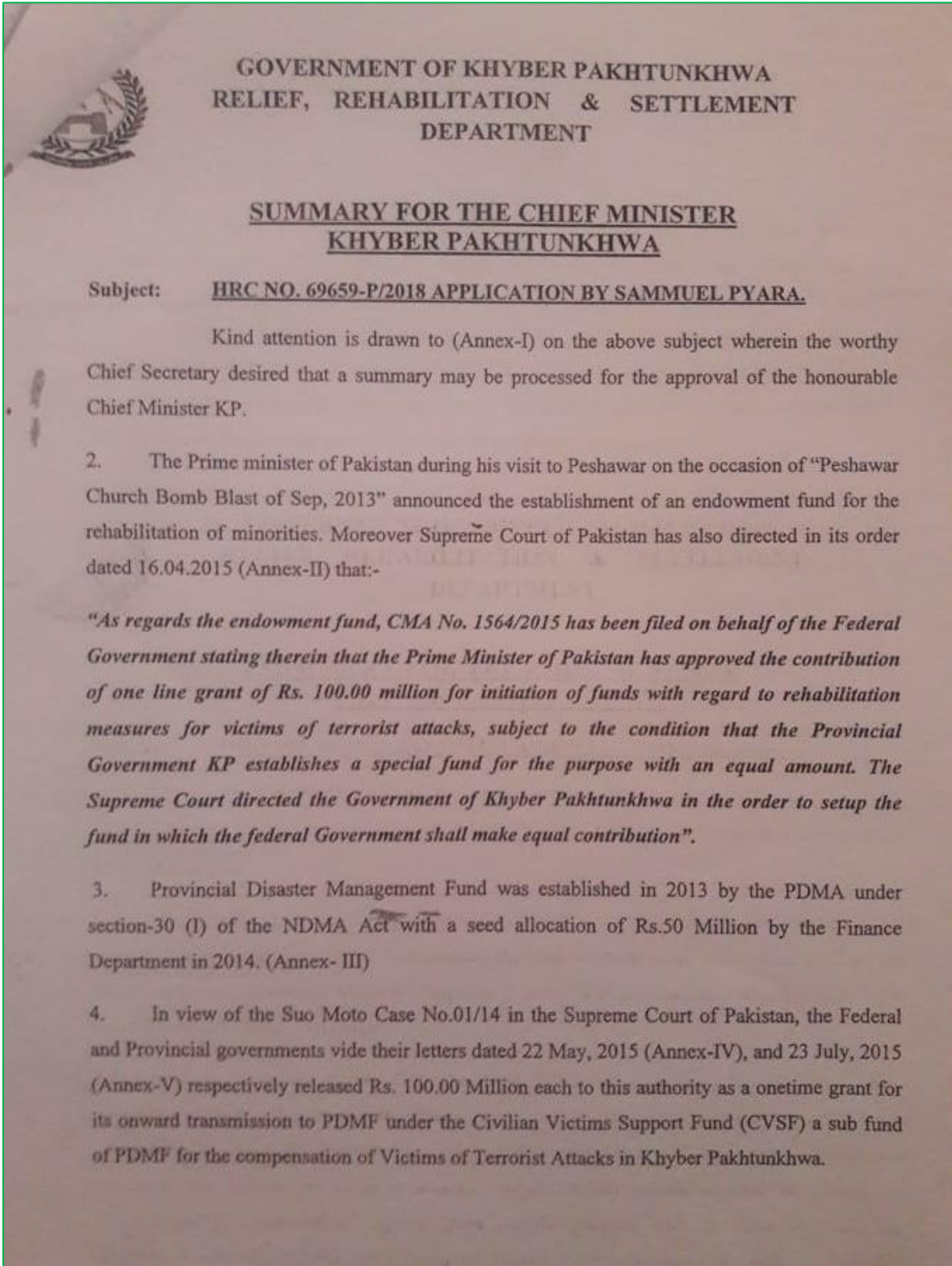

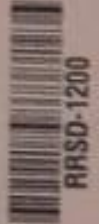

# Religious minorities want basic rights granted

Activists demand national commission, passage of law, and re-initiation of ministry for protection of minorities. — Dawn/File

**LAHORE: Representatives and activists from religious minorities expressed disappointment over the state of law and order nationwide, as crimes against their communities continued unabated.**

Speaking to Dawn, several minority members complained that they were denied their basic rights and many of the laws regarding freedom and safety were not being fully implemented.

“It is ironic that while the Lahore Resolution advocated safeguards for minorities and the protection of their religious, cultural, economic, political and other rights, in the past few days we have been hearing of a new wave of forced conversions in Sindh and south Punjab,” said Samuel Payara, chairperson of Implementation Minority Rights Forum, which earlier held a press conference also in this regard.

“Only a few days ago, we saw the heart-rending video of a Christian woman who was crying and begging for help and safety — she had been paraded naked by some men,” he said.

### ARTICLE CONTINUES AFTER AD

Payara has in the past filed several petitions in court, including demands for compensation for the Peshawar and Quetta church blast victims.

Hindu community activist Amarnath Randhawa said the issue of forced conversions was rising once again.

“Young girls from the Hindu community are being abducted and raped, and at gunpoint married off to Muslim boys even though some of them are already married,” he said. “Even the Sikh community is not safe, as recently in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa a married young Sikh woman was abducted.”

Randhawa also mentioned the case of the Christian woman – a mother of three – who was allegedly abducted from Islamabad and forcibly converted and married to a Muslim man.

Another Hindu community representative alleged that a couple of girls had been kidnapped from south Punjab a couple of days ago. He said that a few years ago the Sindh government had withdrawn a bill aimed at protecting Hindus, in particular, from forced conversions despite the fact that it was passed by the provincial assembly.

The Criminal Law (Protection of Minorities) Bill 2016, presented by then MPA Nand Kumar, mentioned that children under 18 years of age would not be allowed for marriage, however underage Hindu girls were still being kidnapped and forcibly converted.

Payara further said: “On Nov 15, 2018, a decision was made by the former chief justice of Supreme Court that the chairperson of the Evacuee Trust Property Board must belong to the minority community. However, in spite of these orders, no names from the minority community have been sent to the cabinet for approval.”

He also said that most importantly a National Commission of Minorities was needed. He stressed that their demands included immediate action by the prime minister for passing of the Criminal Law (Protection of Minorities) Bill, the Minorities Affairs Ministry be initiated again and this time be headed by a member of the minority community and all Supreme Court orders and directives be implemented.

## Minorities demand increase in job quota

**PESHAWAR** : Implementation of Minority Rights Forum (IMRF) chairman Samuel Payara has demanded increase in job quota for minorities from three to five per cent and appointment of Evacuee Trust Property Board chairman from the non-Muslim communities to ensure protection of their rights.

Speaking at a press conference at Peshawar Press Club on Friday, he expressed his dissatisfaction over the current situation with regard to the rights of minorities and stressed the need for early implementation of the Supreme Court's verdict in letter and spirit.

Flanked by Augustine Jacob, Radish Singh Toni and other minorities' representatives, Mr Pyara recalled that the Supreme Court had already given its decision in 2014 about protection of minorities' rights, but successive governments had failed to implement the verdict so far.

He said that the minorities' groups were repeatedly demanding increase in their job quota from three to five per cent because their population was increasing, but the employment opportunities were the same.

He said that the government had sent a summary of Muslim candidates for appointment of the board chairman which, he claimed, was a violation of the court judgment in this regard, adding that chief of the board should be from among non-Muslims.

The IMRF chief said that the Supreme Court had also issued directions to the federal government to allocate Rs100 million for endowment fund to be disbursed among the affected people of All Saints Church blasts, but the compensation was not yet given.

He said that the women protection bill had been passed in Sindh Assembly wherein the age of marriage for girls would be 18, but the situation of Hindu girls was quite different as

underage girls were forced to marry.

Mr. Payara condemned the alleged forced marriages and conversion of religious minorities in Sindh.

The government, he said, should ensure approval of criminal law protection bill and appoint minorities rights minister from among the minorities` MPAs.





The subject meeting started under the Chairmanship of Special Secretary Home dated 20/06/2019 at 1500 hours in the Conference room of Home Department with introductory remarks by the chair followed by detail progress regarding implementation of the August court decision for provision of security arrangements to various worship places and special events.

2. After detailed brief by Special Secretary Home regarding provision of security arrangements, SP Security KP Police apprised the participants of the meeting that Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police is committed to providing round the clock security for the safety/security of all minority worship places in KP. He further apprised that in some districts security to worship places of minorities is provided on permanent basis while at other locations, security is only provided during worship times or for special events. However, no security is provided at worship places of minorities falling within territorial limits of cantonments except during special events.

3. Following the details shared by SP Security KP Police of the security arrangements, the participants were invited for Question(s)/Answer(s) session regarding security of worship places of minorities.

4. **Representatives of the various minorities groups raised the following main issues.**

- The issue of undisposed garbage was raised by a number of participants
- Late coming of Police , especially ladies Police deployed for security
- Police to raise a special force for protection of minorities worship places
- Complete security arrangement including provision of CCTV cameras/walkthrough gates/barbed wire for protection of premises.
- PC1 preparation for complete security arrangements funding's.
- Police personnel sensitization for dealing with minorities
- Security audit of minorities worship places for security arrangements
- Unregistered minorities places

5. After detailed discussion on the above issues, **the following decisions were taken by the Chair;**

- i): KP Police to revisit HR deployment requirement plan

ii): PC-1 be moved for approval of the provincial government in order to arrange funds for fool proof security arrangements.

iii): KP Police to further improve Police working for performance of duties deployed on worship places of minorities.

iv): All minorities groups to share focal persons with SP Security Police for timely dealing any issue regarding security arrangements.

v): Auqaf Department to collect data related to minorities worship places and share with Police department as well as Home department.

vi): KP police to look into provision of walkthrough gates for security of various worship places of minorities.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to and from the Chair.

Respectfully Sheweth:-

1. That the above noted case is pending for adjudication before this Honourable Court.
2. That the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan, Islamabad, while hearing CMA 4821 of 2018 pertaining to the implementation of S.M. case No.01 of 2014 (the "**Minorities Rights Judgment**") vide its order dated 08.01.2019, was pleased to constitute a Commission headed by Dr. Shoaib Suddle to spear head the efforts relating to the implementation of the Minorities Rights Judgment (Suo Moto No. 1 of 2014 Reported as **PLD 2014 SC 699**).
3. That the Commission submitted its first report on its work on 08.02.2019, in which it reported the administrative, financial and logistical challenges it is facing with regard to its work. Unfortunately, after this report, the matter has not yet been

taken up by the Supreme Court as a result of which the Commission has become practically non-functional. It is submitted that the implementation bench ordered to be formed by the Honorable Supreme Court in its Minority Rights Judgment has not yet been constituted.

4. That the Minorities Rights Judgment in paragraph 37 held, declared and directed:
  - i. *The federal government should constitute a taskforce tasked with developing a strategy of religious tolerance;*
  - ii. *Appropriate curricula be developed at school and college levels to promote a culture of religious and social tolerance. In 1981 in one of its seminal declarations, the United Nations resolved that*  

*“The child shall be protected from any form of discrimination on the grounds of religion or belief. He shall be brought up in the spirit of understanding, tolerance, friendship among people, peace and universal brotherhood, respect for freedom of religion or belief of others, and in full consciousness that his energy and talents should be devoted to the service of his fellow men.” (UN Declaration on the Elimination on All Forms of Intolerance and Discrimination Based on Religion or Belief).*
  - iii. *The Federal Government should take appropriate steps to ensure that hate speeches in social media are discouraged and the delinquents are brought to justice under the law;*
  - iv. *A National Council for minorities’ rights be constituted. The function of the said Council should inter alia be to monitor the practical realization of the rights and safeguards provide to the minorities under the Constitution and law. The Council should also be mandated to frame policy recommendations for safeguarding and protecting minorities’ rights by the Provincial and Federal Government;*
  - v. *A Special Police Force be established with professional training to protect the places of worship of minorities.*

- vi. *In view of the statement made by the Attorney General for Pakistan and learned Additional Advocate Generals of Punjab, KPK and Balochistan regarding reservation of quota for minorities in the federal and provincial services, it is directed that the Federal Government and all Provincial Governments shall ensure the enforcement of the relevant policy directives regarding reservation of quota for minorities in all services.*
- vii. *In all cases of violation of any of the rights guaranteed under the law or desecration of the places of worship of minorities, the concerned Law Enforcing Agencies should promptly take action including the registration of criminal cases against the delinquents.*
- viii. *The office shall open a separate file to be placed before a three Members Bench to ensure that this judgment is given effect to in letter and spirit and the said Bench may also entertain complaints/petitions relatable to violation of Fundamental Rights of minorities.*


5. **That this Honourable Court may also seek the progress report from the concerned authorities regarding Encroachment on Christian Properties alongwith the other issues of Minorities in the light of various Judgments/Orders passed by this Honourable Court on the Encroachment of Christian Properties.**

6. That in the mean time the violation of the rights of the minorities and the lack of safeguards continue to be in the spotlight and there does not seem to be any redressal mechanism in place as it was envisaged in the Minorities Rights Judgment. There is an urgent need for an implementation bench of the Honorable Supreme Court of Pakistan to be constituted to take up reports from the Suddle Commission and to take up other minorities' complaints. Hence, the applicant through this application prays this Honorable Court to constitute a special bench of the Court to oversees' all Minority Rights related matters.

7. That it is submitted that the above violations of the fundamental rights of the Minorities can only be addressed if the Minorities Rights Judgment is implemented in letter in spirit.

In view of the above, it is respectfully prayed that appropriate directions may be given issued for the constitution of an appropriate three Member Bench of the Supreme Court to give effect and implementation for the Minorities Rights according to the various Judgments of this Honourable Court and to take up other complaints on violations of the rights of the Minorities from time to time.

5. In the meeting 99% participants demanded to Draft a Bill on marriages and divorce act 2019 with the collaboration of Christian Religious and Theologians.

**Note: The Right of vote to elect their candidate should be given to Christian Community and also increase the Seats for Minorities.**

A very important meeting with the special secretary Muhammad Khan Ranjha to the Governor Punjab Ch. Muhammad Sarwar held in Governor House Lahore.

A delegation comprises upon Mr. Javed Gill Advocate Legal Head IMRF Team, Rev. Javed Gill Moderator Presbyterian Church of Pakistan, Tariq Siraj Ch. General Secretary IMRF and Chairman IMRF Mr. Samuel Payara met to the Honourable Special Secretary to the Governor Punjab.

Various issues regarding the rights of the minorities were discussed at length. Mr. Chairman IMRF brought into the notice of the learned Secretary that the security of the worship places of the minorities is not satisfactory. A lot is to be done in this regard to stop any unpleasant incidents.

Matter of Minority's Rights Commission Punjab was also discussed, as in the landmark Judgment passed by the worthy Apex Court on June 19, 2014 it was instructed to the provincial governments to form the Minority's Rights Commission to provide the fundamental rights to the religious minorities so that they may have the sense of protection and equal rights but unfortunately after more than 5 years the provincial government could not implement on this judgment.

The delegation also informed the valued secretary about the upcoming INTERFAITH HARMONY, PEACE & RELIGIOUS FREEDOM CONFERENCE to held in December 2019. Special Secretary to Governor Punjab ensured the delegation that the reservations of the religious minorities shall be seen keenly and their equal rights shall be secured by the government at large.

- 1. 1st time in the history of the Pakistan, Baluchistan Government Security Audit of Churches and established PC-1 for the security of Churches in Quetta. RS. 20 CROR**
- 2. On our application Supreme Court of Pakistan took SUO MOTO and victims of Quetta Church Blast got compensation amount (Federal RS. 2 CROR 64 LAC and Provincial Rs. 2 CORO 42 LAC ) and church development fund amount(Rs. 1 CROR 24 LAC) within 3 days.**

After the direction of Supreme Court of Pakistan amount Rs. 72 LAC more was given to the victims.

3. Target Killing in Quetta on Easter 4 person died 1 person injured got compensation amount (RS. 41 LAC)
4. Target Killing Esa Nagri Quetta in front of Church 3 person died and 2 injured got compensation amount (RS. 45 LAC)
5. The big achievement Human Rights Case No. 20171-B of 2018 Supreme Court of Pakistan gave a direction "It has been complained despite the decision taken by the Council of Islamic ideology in its 175th meeting held on 28-29th September, 2009 that there was no harm, as per Shariah Injunctions, to refer to the members of Christian community as "Masihi" instead of "Esai", no steps have been taken by the government in this regard, Let the recommendations of the Council of Islamic Ideology be implemented in letter and spirit and arrangement should be made in all official records, documents, correspondence etc. to refer to the Christian community as "Masihi" instead of "Esai" "
6. In response to our application, under the direction of Supreme Court of Pakistan, Sindh Government gave Compensation amount (approx. Rs. 3 CROR) to victims of Bomb Blast in Peshawar Church)
7. In response to our application, Federal Government gave (Rs. 10 CROR and Provincial Government KPK gave (RS. 10 CROR) in endowment Fund for the victims of Peshawar Church Bomb Blast, unfortunately from after 4 years the KPK Government did not established endowment fund, but now after our struggle this fund is regularized in the Province.
8. In response to our application, Supreme Court of Pakistan took notice and KPK Government is being established endowment fund on RS. 20 CROR
9. In response to our application, PIMS Islamabad has ensured 5% job quota for Minorities
10. 1st time in the history of Pakistan, we published the landmark judgment 19.06.2014 in shape of book and book was inaugurated by the Supreme Court Bar.
11. In response to our application, NADRA submitted report for register Christian Marriage, Punjab and Baluchistan Government had submitted their reports.
12. On our request Information Minister KPK is presenting Minority Rights Commission Bill 2019 in KPK Assembly.

13. On our request IG Islamabad called a meeting on Security of Churches.
14. On our request Chief Secretary Baluchistan calls meeting every month about complaints of Minorities.
15. On our request Home Secretary KPK called meeting for security of churches
16. On Our request Churches Security Audit is being taken place.
17. A Bench has been formed by supermen court of Pakistan after submission of our application dated 03-10-2019 comprises of 3 honorable Judges and established implementation Commission which looks implementation this judgment
18. 75% of Job quota has been implemented from (5% quota)
19. 35% security of churches has been implemented
20. 25% people are become aware of minority rights
21. Bills drafts regarding minority rights commission 2019, Anti-forced conversion and under aged marriages has been submitted to National and Provincial governments
